5 Threshold Proxe

This proxe has been successfully tested with iGen students through Adopt-a-Campus. Non-Christian students have loved the opportunity to tell their story and identify where they are at spiritually. The proxe is attractive, easy to learn, very portable, and attracts both Christians and non-Christians.

5T quiz

The Five Thresholds Faith Journey Quiz is an easy way to meet and start spiritual conversations with strangers. Non-Christians love to place themselves in the thresholds and talk about themselves and their spiritual journey.

1. Use the quiz to meet strangers in the student union like a pocket proxe and invite them to a fun bonding event with your chapter.
2. Have students text a photo of the quiz to friends. Help them follow up.
3. Use the quiz in small group. Ask everyone to identify where they are at in their faith journey and take a step. Let everyone know that the following week you will talk about what it means to move into the following section of the quiz and anyone who wants will be able to decide to follow Jesus.

Network Map

Identify and develop new apprentices/leaders. Use this tool to help students think about the Christians and non-Christians in their networks. The tool features a 5-10 minute devotional (front) and space for draw their network (back). Invite students to consider inviting their networks to small group or use it as an opportunity to help new or potential leaders launch a GIG.

Launch Guide

The launch guide is designed to help students invite friends, share their faith stories, and launch new Bible studies/GIG's. This guide is ideal to help new believers tell their stories and plant in their networks or to use with a small group to help them plant GIG's in the members' networks. Over the course of two weeks students will learn to: interpret their faith story (either new faith story or another recent story of faith), craft and tell their story, invite friends to a launch party, and plan a new faith party.
