

New Believer Mentor/GIG Leader

Coach: Outreach Coordinator

Position Description:

The New Believer Mentor/GIG Leader comes alongside students who have made a profession of faith to disciple them and invite them into the work of sharing the Gospel!

He/she will lead 4-week long GIG plants hosted by new believers. When a student comes to faith, they will “host” a GIG--gather their friends, do the inviting, share their testimony, do the relational investing, etc--but they won’t necessarily lead the bible study. Instead, the New Believer Mentor/GIG Leader will come alongside them, mentor them for a few weeks, and actually lead the bible study portion for them (sort of like co-leading the GIG time).

Because the GIGs will only run for 4 weeks, there will be ebbs and flows to this person’s ministry. For example: If a lot of people come to faith in September, they might be leading a few at once. If no one comes to faith in November, they might not be leading any during that month. They will not be required to do much GIG prep, as GIG guides are already created for this person to use and replicate.

Specific Position Requirements:

- Coach new believers through Bump Set Spike.
- Lead 4 week long GIGs, hosted by new believers. (in certain seasons: 0 hr/wk. In others: up to 4 hours/wk)
- Meet with coach regularly (30 mins/wk)
